MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

For the Period Ended April 30, 2010

General

The following discussion and analysis, prepared as of June 29, 2010, should be read in conjunction with the unaudited financial statements for the six month period ended April 30, 2010 for BRS Ventures Ltd. (the "Company"). The Company's financial statements are prepared in accordance with Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles. The Company's reporting currency is Canadian dollars. The date of this Management Discussion and Analysis is June 29, 2010. Additional information on the Company is available on SEDAR at www.sedar.com.

Nature of Business

BRS Ventures Ltd ("BRS" or the "Company") is a Capital Pool Company ("CPC") as defined by Policy 2.4 of the TSX Venture Exchange (the "Exchange"). As a result, the Company's current business is to identify and evaluate businesses and assets with a view to completing a Qualifying Transaction

Overall Performance

As noted in the BRS Material Change dated April 20, 2009 and Report filed with the TSE Exchange, BRS and Quantum United Technologies Inc (QTI) have executed a letter of agreement in respect of a proposed qualifying transaction under Policy 2.4 of the TSX Venture Exchange.

Further to the Letter of Agreement the Company has now reached agreement on the final terms and conditions, and executed a definitive agreement (the "Definitive Agreement") dated Oct 7th 2009.

Until completion of a Qualifying Transaction, the Company will not carry on any business other than the identification and evaluation of business or assets with a view to completing a potential Qualifying Transaction. With the consent of the Exchange, this may include the raising of additional funds in order to finance an acquisition. Except as described in the Company final prospectus dated January 28, 2008 the funds raised pursuant to the Company initial public offering any subsequent financing will be utilized only for the identification and evaluation of potential Qualifying Transactions.

For the period from incorporation to April 30, 2010 the Company reported no discontinued operations, no changes in accounting policy and declared no cash dividends.

Results of Operations

As at April 30, 2010, the Company had no operations. During the three month period ending April 30, 2010 the Company incurred a net loss of \$85,956. In the period from June 8, 2007 to April 30, 2010 the company incurred a net loss of \$668,817. The loss includes a stock based compensation expense of \$33,150, which is a non-cash based expense.

Liquidity and Capital Resources

As at April 30, 2010, the Company had a negative working capital of \$85,767.

Internal Controls over Financial Reporting Procedures

The Company's management is responsible for establishing and maintaining adequate internal control over financial reporting. Any system of internal control over financial reporting, no matter how well designed, has inherent limitations. Therefore, even those systems determined to be effective can provide only reasonable assurance with respect to financial statement preparation and presentation.

Internal Controls over Financial Reporting Procedures (Continued)

There have been no significant changes in internal controls over financial reporting occurred during the period ended April 30, 2010 that could have materially affected or are reasonably likely to materially affect the Company's internal control over financial reporting.

Disclosure Controls and Procedures

The Company has disclosure controls and procedures in place to provide reasonable assurance that any information to be disclosed by the Company under securities legislation is recorded, processed, summarized and reported within the applicable time periods and to ensure that required information is gathered and communicated to the Company's management so that decisions can be made about timely disclosure of that information.

There have been no significant changes in the Company's disclosure controls during the period ended April 30, 2010 that could significantly affect disclosure controls subsequent to the date the Company carried out its evaluation.

Off-Balance Arrangements

The Company has not entered into any off-balance sheet financing arrangements.

Related Party Transaction

No related party transactions occurred.

Outstanding Share Data

As at April 30, 2010, the Company had outstanding:

- 6,900,000 issued and outstanding common shares;
- 330,000 directors and employees share purchase options;
- 60,000 eligible charitable organization share purchase options;

Subsequent Events

A draft Information Circular, describing the terms and process that constitute the Qualifying Transaction, was presented to the Exchange for approval. The Exchange has subsequently decided not to approve the Qualifying Transaction at this time for reasons of the technology being too early in its development. This delay exceeds the time deadline for a CPC to complete a Qualifying transaction and will mean the company will seek approval from shareholders at the July 20, 2010 Annual Meeting to move to the NEX board. If approved by shareholders the company will have the option of either securing additional time from the Exchange and resources to develop the QTI technology further or seeking a new qualifying transaction.
